

VILLAGE OF PORT CLEMENTS

BY-LAW NO. 112

PROPERTY ACQUISITION BY-LAW

WHEREAS the Village has constructed a Sewerage Lagoon on properties owned by MacMillan Bloedel Limited;

AND WHEREAS MacMillan Bloedel Limited has agreed to sell the property on which the Lagoon is located including a suitable buffer strip;

AND WHEREAS a plan has been prepared for registration and has been signed and sealed by authorized signing officers;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed to be in the best interest of the Village to purchase this property.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Port Clements in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1) The purchase of property described as Lot 1 DL 1828 Plan 9967 Queen Charlotte District for a sum of Five Hundred Dollars.

2) The payment of costs to conduct a legal survey, preparation and registration of plans for:

- A) Lagoon and a buffer strip,
- B) Easements over company lands for road, force main and outfall pipes;

3) Payment of legal and administrative costs.

4) Payment is to be made out of General Revenue fund to a maximum of Four thousand dollars; AND

5) The mayor and Clerk are authorized to sign and seal any and all agreements connected with this requisition.

6) This By-Law may be cited as the Village of Port Clements Property Acquisition By-Law No. 112, 1981.
