READ A SECOND TIME THIS 4th OF May, 1992.

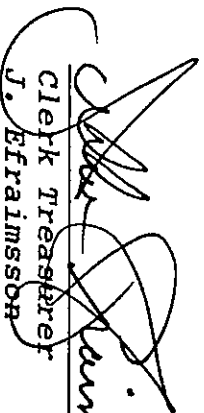
READ A THIRD TIME THIS 4th OF May, 1992.

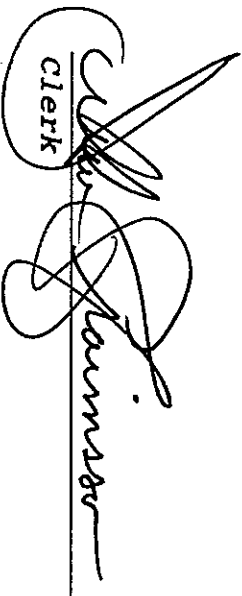

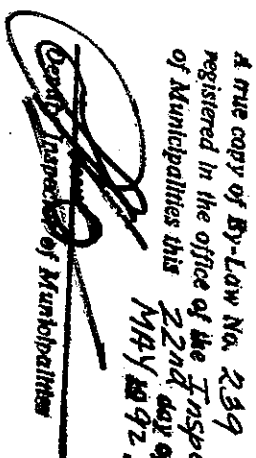
