

VILLAGE OF PORT CLEMENTS

BYLAW NO. 301

A Bylaw to provide remuneration to the Council for the Village of Port Clements

WHEREAS, under the provision of the Municipal Act, the Council may provide a bylaw for paying out of the annual revenue, an indemnity to the Mayor and to the Councillors, and the indemnity for the Mayor may be greater than for other members of Council;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council for the Village of Port Clements in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. There shall be paid out of the Annual Revenue an annual indemnity to the Mayor of Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500.00) and to each of the Councillors Two Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$2,100.00)
2. One third of the Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500.00) remuneration paid to the Mayor and one third of the Two Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$2,100.00) paid to the Councillors shall be paid as an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of their duties as members of Council.
3. This bylaw may be cited as "Council Remuneration Bylaw No. 301, 1999."


