

VILLAGE OF PORT CLEMENTS

BYLAW NO. 317, 2001

A bylaw to establish the operation, maintenance and administration of Port Clements Harbour and the former Port Clements Government Wharf and facilities.

WHEREAS section 517 (1) of the *Local Government Act* RSBC 1996, Chapter 323, empowers the local government to operate any service that the Council considers necessary or desirable for all or part of the municipality.

AND WHEREAS the Village of Port Clements desires to operate, maintain and administer the Port Clements Harbour and Wharf for the benefit of the residents of the Village of Port Clements.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Port Clements in open meeting assembled enacts the following:

1. TITLE

This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Port Clements Harbour Operation, Maintenance, and Administration Bylaw No. 317, 2001".

2. INTERPRETATION

In this bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires;

2. the words "the Village" shall mean the Village of Port Clements;
3. the words "the Council" shall mean the Council of the Village of Port Clements'
4. the words "the Port Clements Wharf shall mean the former Government Wharf, so called, and facilities;
5. the words "the Harbour" shall mean the wharf and the surrounding water lease.

3. Establishment

It shall be lawful for the Council to establish, and the same is hereby established, operate, maintain and administer the Port Clements Wharf and the Port Clements Harbour.

The Council may establish berthage rates and such other rates or fees as are deemed necessary.

The Council may pay out such monies as may be requisite for any expenses to operate, maintain and administer the Port Clements Wharf and the Port Clements Harbour.

The Council may by resolution and is hereby empowered to:

- a. Enter into a contract with an individual, individuals or company for the management of the Port Clements Wharf and the Port Clements Harbour.
- b. Fix by written agreement charges made for extra services.
- c. Make any other regulation necessary for the safe and efficient operation of the facility.
