BY-LAW NO. 38

BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF PORT CLEMENTS TO PROVIDE FOR THE HOLDING OF AN ADVANCE POLL AT ALL ELECTIONS, OR, SUBMISSIONS TO THE ELECTORS OF THE VILLAGE OF PORT CLEMENTS.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 54 of the "Municipal Act" the Council of the Village of Port Clements have deemed it expedient to provide for the holding of an advanced poll at all elections, including submissions to the electors;

AND WHEREAS Council wish to establish hours in which the advance poll will be open;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Port Clements in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

I. Title

This by-law may be cited for all purposes as the "Village of Port Clements Advance Poll By-law , 1976".

II Establishment of Advance Poll:

1. That on the Wednesday and Thursday immediately proceeding each election or submission to the electors of the Village of Port Clements there shall be held an advanced poll at the Municipal Office in the Village of Port Clements between the hours of seven o'clock (7:00 p.m.) in the afternoon and nine o'clock (9:00 p.m.) in the afternoon.

2. That in the event an election or submission shall be held on a Monday, the advanced poll will be held on the Wednesday and Thursday immediately proceeding the aforesaid Monday at the place and times mentioned in subsection 1.

3. That the persons permitted to vote at said advanced poll are those duly qualified electors who sign a statement to the effect that:

(a) they expect to be absent from the Municipality on the polling day or

(b) they are, for reasons of conscience, prevented from voting on polling day or

(c) through circumstances beyond their control they will not be able to attend the poll on polling day.

III. Adoption:

This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of registration in the office of the Inspector of Municipalities.


